The applicant **James G & Margaret H. Metternich**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a Portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 17756 Cert #5714**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 17756, Certificate 5714 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 17756, Certificate 5714 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on December 31, 1999 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The issuance of Permit 64816-T expires Permit 63939-T.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.20 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 55.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.


