The applicant William R. Tomerlin, Trust dated August 11, 1976, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a Portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 50092

1. The source of water is An underground source
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.0822 CFS not to exceed 12.0 acre feet per year.
3. The water to be used for No change.
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, T12N, R19E, MDB&M or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 10 bears N 86 $^{\circ}$ 03' 01" W, 822.50 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, T12N, R19E, MDB&M or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 10 bears N 67 $^{\circ}$ 17' 20" W, 676.64 Feet.
7. Proposed place of use 3.0 acres within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, T12N, R19E, MDB&M, Douglas County, Nevada.
8. Existing place of use 3.0 acres within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, T12N, R19E, MDB&M, Douglas County, Nevada.
9. Use will be from 1 January to 31 December of each year.
10. Use was permitted from 1 January to 31 December of each year.
11. Description of proposed works drilled well equipped with a 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ HP submersible pump, 2 inch totalizing meter and distribution line to hand set sprinkler lines.
12. Estimated cost of works Completed
13. Estimated time required to construct works Completed - Drilled well with an 8 inch casing - 250 feet deep.
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 1 Year
15. Remarks: This Application is being filed as described in option 1 in the letter from Matthew L. Nussbaumer dated July 3, 1996 regarding Permit 50092.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 50092 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 50092 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0822 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 12.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

June 23, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

July 23, 2000

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

June 23, 2001

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

July 23, 2001

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

July 23, 2001


