The applicant **Carmel of Jesus, Mary and Joseph**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion and place of use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit # 26810**

1. The source of water is **Underground source**
2. The amount of water to be changed **Two acre feet, .0050 CFS**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **Within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7 Township 19 South, Range 59 East, MDM from which the center one-quarter (C $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 7, Township 19 south, Range 59 East, MDM bears North 55°40" East a distance of 1520.0 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **The Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 61 East, MDM, or at a point fro which the center quarter (C $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 61 East, MDM Bears South 68°22'08" West a distance of 1493.80 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **South half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the North half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) North half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 7, township 19 south Range 59 East MDM**
8. Existing place of use **1.13 acres located in a portion of the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and a portion of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 2, Township 22 south Range 61 East. Acreage to be removed from irrigation equals 0.44 acre 2 acre feet of water are being transferred.**
9. Use will be from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Drill 8 inch steel cased well, install 5HP submersible pump, meter, piping, storage tanks, pressure tanks booster pump and appruntenances**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$30,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **1 year**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**

15. Remarks: Water to be used for irrigation purposes for a Monastery and Chapel. A recent application for commercial purposes has been filed under #64829. This water will be using the same well filed under said 64829.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 26810, Certificate 8427 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 26810, Certificate 8427 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second, **but not to exceed 2.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

June 7, 2001

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

July 7, 2001

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

June 7, 2004

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

July 7, 2004




