

**APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC
WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA**

The applicant **Sierra Ready Mix, LLC.**, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **underground source**
2. The amount of water applied for is **one second-foot**
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **industrial**
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered
 - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks") **wash 4,000 TPD sand and rock**
 - (d) Power:
 - (1) Horsepower developed **n/a**
 - (2) Point of return of water to stream **n/a**
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point within the **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, T26S, R60E, Mt. Diablo B&M** at a point where the NW corner of said Section 6 bears **N 34⁰ 41' W 3,879 ft.**
6. Place of Use Within the **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, T26S, R60E**
7. Use will begin about **Jan 1** and end about **Dec 31** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **from an 850 foot 8" diameter well equipped with a 60 hp pump, piped to a screening and wash Plant (see #12 below)**
9. Estimated cost of works **\$85,000**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **2 yrs**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **3 yrs**
12. Remarks: **Water required to a total duty of 400 acre feet per year for washing and screening 4000 tons per day. Waste water to be re-used. Evaporation losses and moisture contained in product cannot be returned.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance issued under the provisions of NRS 533.371 for a finite period of time. This permit will expire on **December 6, 2015** and all rights herein will revert back to the source. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This permit is issued as a preferred use and any change of the point of diversion outside of the general area of the permit will not be allowed.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 150.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

December 6, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

January 6, 2001

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

December 6, 2015

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use:


