APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued for the irrigation of 68.7 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.427 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 206.1 acre-feet seasonally, and not to exceed a seasonal duty of 3.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

January 2, 2004

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

February 2, 2004

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

January 2, 2005

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 2, 2005

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 2, 2005
