The applicant **Hoss Equipment Nevada, Inc.**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Place of Use, and Manner of Use** of water heretofore appropriated under a portion of Permit 60878

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.05 cfs, not to exceed 2 acre-feet per year**
3. The water to be used for **Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Industrial (Gravel Operations)**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, Township 20 North, Range 22 East, M.D.M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 27 bears N 60° 50' W, a distance of 2,743.3 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, Township 20 North, Range 22 East, M.D.M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 27 bears N 51° 16' W a distance of 1,371.3 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, Township 20 North, Range 22 East, M.D.M.**
8. Existing place of use **All of Section 27, Township 20 North, Range 22 East, M.D.M.**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Clean-out existing 6" diameter well, install submersible pump, flow meter and pipeline.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$5,000.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **1 month**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **1 year**
15. Remarks: **An existing well will be equipped to provide domestic water to a temporary construction office trailer located on the north side of Interstate 80.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 60878 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 60878 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 60877, 60878 and 65318-T shall not exceed 484.0 acre-feet annually.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **November 30, 2000** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.




