The applicant Michael Faretto Family 1996 Trust (1/2 Interest) Anderson Family 1992 Trust (1/2 Interest), hereby make application for permission to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 30193, Certificate 9859

1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.5112 c.f.s., 116.08 AFS
3. The water to be used for Irrigation
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW1/4 SW1/4, Sec. 11, T.12N., R.25E., MDB&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Sec. 11 bears S 87° 27' 11" W, a distance of 760.05 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE1/4 NW1/4, Sec. 35, T.13N., R.25E., MDB&M., or at a point from which the NE Corner of said Sec. 35 bears N 56° 26' 25" E, a distance of 4698.35 feet.
7. Proposed place of use Portions of the E1/2 SE1/4, Sec. 10 and W1/2 SW1/4, Sec. 11, T.12N R.25E., MDB&M, 19.02 acres.
8. Existing place of use 4.37 acres in the NW1/4 NE1/4, Sec. 34, T.13N., R.25E., MBD&M and 24.65 acres in the NE1/4 NE1/4, Sec. 34, T.13N., R.25E., MDB&M. A total of 29.02 acres.
9. Use will be from April 1 to November 30 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from April 1 to November 30 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Well, pump and irrigation system
12. Estimated cost of works \$20,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30193, Certificate 9859 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30193, Certificate 9859 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 65384, and any waters of the Walker River Decree, and any storage water appurtenant to the place of use shall not exceed 116.08 acre-feet per season. The seasonal period of use will be from April 1st to November 30th of each year. The permittee is responsible for ensuring delivery of the entitled decreed and storage waters that are supplemental to Permit 65384. In any year that the Walker River Irrigation District declares a full allocation of decreed waters to the priority years of C-125 claims supplemental to Permit 65384, underground water shall not be pumped from the well described in this permit. In any year that the Walker River Irrigation District has no decreed or storage water, or declares a reduced allocation of surface waters to the priority years of C-125 claims supplemental to Permit 65384, then the place of use of the permit can be irrigated with underground water, but not to exceed a duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season from the total of decreed, storage, and underground waters.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.5112 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 116.08 acre-feet seasonally, and not to exceed a seasonal duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

January 31, 2002

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

March 1, 2002

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

January 31, 2005

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 1, 2005

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 1, 2005


