July 27, 2003





The applicant **Dorothy Lemelson**, hereby makes application for permission to change the place of use of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 56614**

1. The source of water is **Second Creek**
2. The amount of water to be changed **.02 cfs, not to exceed 4.47 afa**
3. The water to be used for **irrigation and domestic purposes**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **irrigation and domestic purposes**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 17, T.16N., R.18E., MSB&M, at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 17 bears N 26°33' E, a distance of 760.7 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within
7. Proposed place of use **within Parcel B (APN 122-100-24) and Parcel A (APN 122-100-23), within portion of Lot 1, Section 16 and Lot IV, Sec 17, all within T.16N. R.18E., MDB&M.**
8. Existing place of use **within 4 parcels (APN 122-100-03, 04, 05 & 06) being within portions of Lot 1, Section 16, and Lot IV, Sec. 17 all within T.16N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M. (see map under Permit 56614).**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **concrete dam with overflow. Water diverted above overflow into 6" PVC pipes for irrigation purposes. Pumps will possibly be used to attain appropriate pressure for designed sprinkler system.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$7500**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **2 years**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **4 years**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of the waters of Second Creek heretofore granted under Permit 56614 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56614 and with the understanding that no other rights at the source shall be affected by the change proposed herein. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to a beneficial use. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit is limited to the irrigation of 1.1 acres within the described place of use.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.
