The applicant **Desert Pearl Farms**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion and Place and Manner of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 56798**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.407 c.f.s., 116.672 AFS**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34, T.15N., R.25E., MDM; or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 34 bears South 25° 56' 42" East, 3084.87 feet**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T.13N., R.26E., MDM, or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 36, T.13N., R.25E., MDM bears North 60° 17' 44" West, 6637.28 feet**
7. Proposed place of use **29.168 acres within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34, T.15N., R.25E., MDM**
8. Existing place of use **within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (40 acres) and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (18 acres) Section 31, T.13N., R.26E., MDM, 29.168 acres to be removed from irrigation**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **March 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **drilled well, pump and motor, and irrigation distribution system**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$50,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **1 year**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **3 years**
15. Remarks: **The water under this application and applications to change Permits 61127 and 61128, being filed concurrently, is not to exceed 300.0 acre-feet per year. The underground water is to be supplemental to Walker River rights within the proposed place of use. The applicant has a lease on the property within the proposed place of use, and an agreement to use the well under the proposed point of diversion. The applicant anticipates moving the water rights back to the existing point of diversion and place of use under Permit 56798 (in the Pumpkin Hollow area), upon termination of the lease.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use, and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56798 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56798 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 65777, 65778, and 65779 shall not exceed 300.0 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.407 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 116.672 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

May 19, 2002

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

June 19, 2002

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

May 19, 2005

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 19, 2005

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 19, 2005


