The applicant **Lance O'Banion**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion & Place of Use** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 64961**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.0277 cfs, not to exceed 20 acre-feet annually**
3. The water to be used for **irrigation**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **irrigation**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, Section 23, T.11N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Corner of said Section 23 bears N. 76°22'20" E, a distance of 5,540.60 feet**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 64691 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 64691 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **December 31, 2000** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit is limited to the irrigation of 5.0 acres within the described place of use.





APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of a geothermal source as heretofore granted under Permit 62924 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 62924 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the changed proposed herein.

It is understood that the amount of geothermal fluid herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable decrease of fluid pressure and heat. The well shall be equipped and maintained to prevent any waste of the geothermal fluid. Accurate measurements must be kept of discharge of the production well and the amount of fluid injected into the injection well to determine the total amount of fluid diverted and consumed for a beneficial use.

The production and injection well are to be cemented from the producing levels to the surface to protect fresh water zones. This permit is issued subject to the condition that only geothermal fluids are to be diverted and used beneficially for heating purposes and fresh, cold water aquifers are not to be diverted. The used geothermal fluids are to be returned to the source via the injection well. A detailed log on the injection well and/or other analyses of the system used for returning the used geothermal fluids to the source must be submitted together with the Proof of Completion.

An annual report for this well must be filed under this permit describing the amount of geothermal fluid diverted and consumed to a beneficial use for the calendar year. This report must detail the amount of fluid produced and injected.

The total consumptive use under Permits 51322, 63702, and 66088 shall not exceed 1,303.0 acre-feet annually.

The total withdrawal of the geothermal fluid shall be limited to 3,258.0 acre-feet per year but the total consumptive use of the geothermal fluid is limited to only incidental fluid losses in the system and in no case shall it amount to more than 20 percent of the right to make a determination of incidental fluid losses at any time and impose additional conditions thereto. This permit is further issued subject to the provisions of NRS 533.372(1) and with the understanding that the power or energy generated by the beneficial use of this water or steam is subject to recapture and use within the boundaries of the State of Nevada when the need arises.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.






