APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of wildlife served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.002 cubic feet per second or, or sufficient to water 20 head of horses, 100 head of deer, and 25 head of elk.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

May 19, 2011

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





The applicant **United States Dept. of the Interior Bureau of Land Management**, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

6. Place of Use **SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 16, T.1S., R.70E., M.D.M. in unsurveyed land.**
7. Use will begin about **Jan 1** and end about **December 31** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **From Pre-existing well, use a submersible pump pipe and tank for watering.**
9. Estimated cost of works **5,000 dollars**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **One year.**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **one year**
