The applicant **Carter Griffin, Inc.** hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **Dee Gee Spring**

6. Place of Use **within the Lot 2 of Section 31, T.10N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M.**
7. Use will begin about **January 1st** and end about **December 31st** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **This is an existing developed spring with a 650 gallon storage tank.**
9. Estimated cost of works is **\$4,000**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **3 years**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0375 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 1,200 head of cattle.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

February 12, 2003

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

March 12, 2003

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

February 12, 2006

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 12, 2006


