The applicant **Poagy's Patch**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion Place of Use and Manner of Use** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit No. 63520**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.00532 c.f.s. – 3.84 a.f.a.**
3. The water to be used for **Commercial and Domestic use**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic use**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SW¼ SE¼ Section 22, T22N, R21E, MDM, or at a point from which the S¼ corner of said Section 22, bears S 44° 29' 45" W, a distance of 1430.60 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SW¼ SW¼ of Section 29, T23N, R21E, MDM, or at a point From which the SW corner of said Section 29, bears S 72° 04' 05" W, a distance of 1009.34 feet. Ref to supporting map filed under Permit No. 63519**
7. Proposed place of use **SE¼ SE¼ and SW¼ SE¼ of Section 22, T22N, R21E, MDM.**
8. Existing place of use **0.96 acres within the SE¼ SE¼ of Section 30 and the SW¼ SW¼ of Section 29, T23N, R21E, M.D.M. – Ref to supporting map filed under Permit No. 63519**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Existing**
12. Estimated cost of works **Existing**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Existing**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **Five (5) years**
15. Remarks: **A drip system will be installed to irrigate cane berries. Researched University of Nevada Extension for information regarding water usage for this crop. No information was available. Talking with Dr Wayne Johnson at the University of Nevada it was his opinion that cane berries would use approx. 1.5 to 2.0 acre feet per year. Ref to letter dated May 15, 2000.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use, and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 63520 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 63520 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 66410 and 66411 shall not exceed 4.96 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.00532 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 3.84 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

January 17, 2002

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

February 17, 2002

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

January 17, 2003

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 17, 2003

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
