APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 48454 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 48454 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 66548 and 66549 shall not exceed 26.06 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Any well drilled under this permit shall be drilled in what has been described in the United States Geological Survey Water Supply Paper 2263 as the intermediate alluvial aquifer. In no instance shall the seal on this well be less than 100 feet below ground level.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.1347 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 23.16 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

August 5, 2003

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

August 5, 2006

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

August 5, 2006

The applicant **Bruce Alan Cunningham**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use** of water heretofore appropriated under a portion of Permit No. 48454

1. The source of water is **underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.15152 cfs, 26.06 acre feet annually**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **within the SW¹/₄ of the SE¹/₄ of Section 3, T.20N., R.27E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the southwest corner of said Section 3 bears South 89°02' West a distance of 2666 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **within the NE¹/₄ of the NE¹/₄ of Section 18, T.19N., R.27E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the northeast corner of said Section 18 bears North 65°39'35" East a distance of 1170.29 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **portions of Section 3, T.20N., R.27E., M.D.M.; 5.79 acres within Churchill County Assessor's Parcel Number 09-291-05, exact location to be determined later.**
8. Existing place of use **5.79 acres within the NE¹/₄ of the NE¹/₄ of Section 18, T.19N., R.27E. M.D.M..**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **drilled well, pump and pipeline**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$40,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **3 years**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**
15. Remarks: **This right is supplemental to the surface right under Permit No. 48453, and a corresponding amount is being changed to the Proposed Place of Use in Section 3, T.20N., R.27E., M.D.M.. If permitted, this right would be used on property owned by the Desert Gun Club when permit is ready for action**




