APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 65724 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 65724 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 45856, 49258, 53913, 56856, 65724, and Temporary Permit 66891-T shall not exceed 2,631.0 acre-feet annually.

This temporary permit is issued supplemental to Walker River Decreed and Storage rights.

The place of use is limited to 68.75 acres as described under Temporary Permit 66891-T and 589.0 acres within the 657.75 acres from the balance of the permits.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **November 16, 2001** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.



Item 15. Remarks

The water under this application is for irrigation of 68.75 acres and is to be in addition to water under Permit 66303, for 93.75 acres total. The applicant is leasing the land within the place of use for approximately 2 years.

The water under base right Permit 65724 is supplemental to water under Permits 45856, 45258, 53913, and 56856, for irrigation of 657.75 acres. This supplemental acreage will be reduced to 589 acres during the period that the lease is in effect.

Use proof of beneficial use map on file at the Division of Water Resources under Permit 45856 to support the existing place of use, map filed under Application 66303 to support the proposed place of use, and map filed under Application 65724 to support the proposed and existing point of diversion.
