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The applicant **Talapoosa Mining, Inc.**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of diversion, Place and Manner of Use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 52005**

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1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **1.0 c.f.s., up to 10 million gallons total use**
3. The water to be used for **Construction completion & initial filling of new sewer ponds for Silver Springs G.I.D.**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Milling and Mining**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 25, T.18 N., R.24 E., MDM, or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 25 bears North 47°25' West, 1155 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 10, T.18 N., R.24 E., MDM, or at a point from which the E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> corner of Section 3, T.18 N., R.24 E., bears N.10°49' E., 5355.26 feet**
7. Proposed place of use **within the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 20, T.18 N., R.25 E., MDM, as shown on the attached sketch**
8. Existing place of use **S<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Section 3, T.18 N., R.24 E., MDM**
9. Use will be from **Approval to June 30, 2001** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Drilled well, pump, motor, and pipeline to the new sewer collection system**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$10,000.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **2 weeks**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **n/a**
15. Remarks: **Silver Springs Airport has entered into an agreement to lease water rights from Talapoosa Mining, Inc. This water is to allow filling of the new sewage storage facilities of the Silver Springs G.I.D. because initial sewer flows will be insufficient.**

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place of use, and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 52005 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 52005 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 52005, 52006, 52007, 52008, 52009, 52010, and Temporary Permit 66908-T shall not exceed 100.0 million gallons annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **November 27, 2001** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.
