The applicant **James R. Buell, VMD**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **point of diversion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 21324 Certificate 5966**

1. The source of water is **underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **1.12 cfs**
3. The water to be used for **irrigation and domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **irrigation and domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **within the NW¼ SE¼ of Section 22, T.46N., R.33E., MDB&M or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 27, T.46N., R.33E., MDB&M bears S 12° 37' E 7300 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **the NE¼ NE¼ of Section 22, T.46N., R.33E., MDB&M or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 22 bears N 86° 37' 20" E 1051.11 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **unchanged**
8. Existing place of use **39.8 acres in the NE¼ NE¼ of Section 22, T.46N., R.33E., MDB&M

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions.

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 21324, Certificate 5966 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 21324, Certificate 5966 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 16589, Certificate 5945; 21324, Certificate 5966, and Temporary Permit 67353-T shall not exceed 1,238.8 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **April 26, 2002** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.12 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 475.08 acre-feet seasonally, and not to exceed a seasonal duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
