The applicant **Phillip and Sherrie Hermann Trust** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a Portion of water** heretofore appropriated under **Permit #15032 Certificate #8712**

1. The source of water is **Underground Source**
2. The amount of water to be changed **6 Acre Feet, 0.0083 C.F.S.**
3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Quasi-Municipal**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **Within the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 9, T22S, R61E, MDM, or at a point from which the East one-quarter (E $\frac{1}{4}$) corner of said Section 9, T22S, R61E, MDM bears south 62° 39' East a distance of 1354.0 Feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **The Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 9, T21S, R61E, MDM, or at a point from which the Northeast corner of said Section 9, T21S, R61E, MDM bears North 22° 48' 00" East a distance of 945.34 Feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **Government Lot 28, being the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 9, T22S, R61E, MDM Assessor Parcel Number 177-09-603-012**
8. Existing place of use **Portion of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the North-east Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 9, and a portion of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 10, T21S R61E, MDM.**
9. Use will be from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1st to December 31st** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Well is existing and complete. Install Totalizing Meter.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$1,500.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Well is 262 Feet Deep, 3 Hp Submersible Pump, 2500 Gallon Storage TANK, 2 Bladder tanks, 5 Hp Booster Pump, and appurtenances.**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **Five (5) Years.**

15. Remarks: Water to supplement existing quasi-municipal uses for the property and existing residence.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 15032, Certificate 8712 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 15032, Certificate 8712 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Permit 67491 is issued to provide water service to one lot described by Clark County Assessor's Parcel Number 177-09-603-012.

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0083 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 6.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

March 19, 2003

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

April 19, 2003

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

March 19, 2006

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

April 19, 2006

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
