The applicant Nevada Division of Wildlife, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **unnamed spring**
2. The amount of water applied for is **0.2 c.f.s.** second-feet
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **Public Recreation & Wildlife Purposes**
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

 - (1) Horsepower developed

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **NE¼ SW¼, Sec. 25, T.15N., R.32E., M.D.B.&M. (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the SW Cor. of Sec. 31, T.16N., R.33E., M.D.B.&M. bears N 2°39' W a distance of 22,470 feet.**
6. Place of Use **NE¼ SW¼, Sec. 25, T.15N., R.32E., M.D.B.&M., (unsurveyed)**
7. Use will begin about **January 1** and end about **December 31** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **spring source**
9. Estimated cost of works **\$1,000**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **completed**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **3 years**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of wildlife served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed .01 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 20 antelope, 60 bighorn sheep, 30 mule deer and desert fowl.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed

on or before:

August 13, 2003

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

September 13, 2003

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

August 13, 2005

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 13, 2005

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




