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The applicant **Colvin and Son, LLC**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **point of diversion and place of use** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit #13544 (Rim Rock Well)**

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1. The source of water is **underground Box Canyon Well**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.032 c.f.s.**
3. The water to be used for **stock watering**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **stock watering**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **within the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 18, T.8N., R.49E., M.D.M. from which the E. <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>-section corner of said section 18 bears S.34°46'E. 441 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 17, T.8N., R.49E., M.D.M. from which the W.<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>-corner of said Section 17 bears N.41°37'W., 1,997 ft. distant**
7. Proposed place of use **SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 18, T.8N., R.49E., M.D.M.**
8. Existing place of use **SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 17, T.8N., R.49E., M.D.M.**
9. Use will be from **April 1 to November 15** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **April 1 to November 15** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **hand-dug well, collection pipe, storage tanks, pipeline and troughs**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$5,000.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **two years**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **three years**

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 67823, 67824 and 67825 shall not exceed 8.10 million gallons annually or sufficient to water 1100 head of cattle.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Any application to change the manner of use or the place of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.032 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 1100 head of cattle.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

October 18, 2008

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

November 18, 2008

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

October 18, 2011

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

November 18, 2011

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


