The applicant Pavich & Associates, Inc. hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 59607

- 1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.1143 c.f.s. (20.20 acre feet)
3. The water to be used for Quasi-municipal & Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for unchanged
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 17, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said section 17 bears, S 70° 03' 00" E., a distance of 3440 feet. Please refer to map filed under Application 42118.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW 1/4 SE 1/4, section 19, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said section 19, bears S. 52° 27' 32" E., 1,721.74 feet. Please refer to map filed under permit 59607.
7. Proposed place of use SE 1/4, NE 1/4, E 1/2 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 20, and SE 1/4 SW 1/4, portions of the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 SE 1/4, section 17 and the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, section 16, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M. Please refer to map filed under application 42118.
8. Existing place of use SW 1/4 SE 1/4 and portions of W 1/2 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of section 19 and NW 1/4 NE 1/4 section 30, all in T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M. Please refer to map filed under permit 59607.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Drilled well, pump, motor, storage tanks and distribution systems
12. Estimated cost of works \$250,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works 5 years
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 10 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 59607 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 59607 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.1143 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 20.20 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

September 22, 2006

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

October 22, 2006

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

September 22, 2009

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

October 22, 2009

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


