
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**DENIAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

The protests to this application are hereby upheld in part and the application is hereby denied on the grounds that there is no unappropriated groundwater at the source of the supply, the proposed use would conflict with existing rights in the Order 1169 basins and the proposed use of the water would threaten to prove detrimental to the public interest in that it would threaten the water resources upon which the endangered Moapa dace are dependent. No ruling is made on the merits of the remaining protest grounds.

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The applicant **Dry Lake Water, L.L.C.** hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

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1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **Underground Source in Basin 218**
2. The amount of water applied for is **10 (ten)** second-feet
  - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **qusai-municipal**
4. If use is for:
  - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated **n/a**
  - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered **n/a**
  - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks") **See No. 12**
  - (d) Power:

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point at a point within the **NE¼, NW¼ Sec. 4, T19S, R64E, MDM** or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 4, T19S, R64E, bears **N 76° 04' 29" W, 1560.14 feet.**
6. Place of Use **The exact places of use within the Apex Industrial Park are within the "place of use" boundary on the map accompanying the applications. The description of the lands within that boundary are more specifically listed below: Township 16 South, Range 63 East: Parts of Sections 32 and 33; Township 18 South, Range 63 East: Parts of Sections 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35. Township 19 South, Range 63 East: Parts of Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9.**
7. Use will begin about **January 1st.** and end about **December 31st.** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **Water is to be diverted from wells through pipelines to storage tanks in place of use (see map). Design of system depends on the amount and location of water developed.**
9. Estimated cost of works **\$5 million**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **5 (five) years**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 (five) years**
