The applicant Darren Wilson and Cheryl Wilson makes application for permission to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit #15032, Cert. #8712

- 1. The source of water is underground source
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.00168 C.F.S., One (1) Acre Foot
3. The water to be used for quasi-municipal purposes
4. The water heretofore permitted for quasi-municipal purposes
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4), Section 20, T22S, R61E, MDM, or at a point from which the center one-quarter (C 1/4) corner of said Section 20, T22S, R61E, MDM, bears North 35°06'02" East a distance of 1213.63 Feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within a portion of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4), Section 9, T21S, R61E MDM, or at a point from which the Northeast corner of said Section 9, T21S, R61E, MDM, bears North 22°48'00" East a distance of 945.34 Feet.
7. Proposed place of use Lot one (1) of Parcel Maps, File 73, Page 57, Clark County, Nevada official records, being a portion of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SE 1/4), Section 20, T22S, R61E, MDM. Assessor Parcel Number 177-20-304-006.
8. Existing place of use portion of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4), Section 9, and a portion of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4), Section 10, T21S, R61E, MDM.
9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Well has been drilled under Permit #57542, and is complete.
12. Estimated cost of works None
13. Estimated time required to construct works None
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use Three (3) Years
15. Remarks: Water to be used for the existing residence for quasi-municipal purposes.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 15032, Certificate 8712 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 15032, Certificate 8712 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

A separate totalizing meter must be installed so that it measures only the place of use described as Clark County Assessor's Parcel Number 177-20-304-006.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.00168 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

May 20, 2003

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

June 20, 2003

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

May 20, 2005

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 20, 2005

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


