The applicant Granite Construction Company hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Place and Manner of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Truckee River Decree Claim No. 626A - United States of America vs Orr Ditch Company in Equity Docket A-3

- 1. The source of water is Truckee River
2. The amount of water to be changed 100.0 acre feet per annum
3. The water to be used for Industrial Purposes
4. The water heretofore permitted for As Decreed Purposes
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point w/in NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 18 T19N, R21E, MDM or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 18 bears N 21 degrees 30 minutes E, a distance of 3,602.0 feet (Largomarsino-Noce Ditch)
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within w/in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 11 T19N, R21E, MDM (McCarran North Side Ditch)
7. Proposed place of use All of the N 1/2 of Section 17 and that portion of the S 1/2 of Section 17 lying north of the northerly right-of-way line of Interstate Highway 80, T19N, R21E, MDM.
8. Existing place of use 100.0 acre feet located south of the Interstate Highway 80 right-of-way and north of the Truckee River within the Westerly most portion of Truckee River Claim No. 626A.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from As Decreed to As Decreed of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Existing rock diversion structure in the Truckee River for the Largomarsino-Noce Ditch.
12. Estimated cost of works None - existing
13. Estimated time required to construct works None - existing
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years
15. Remarks: Refer to map filed under Application to Change No. 65495 to support the proposed point of diversion and place of use.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim 626a, Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The issuance of this permit fully abrogates 100 acre-feet per season associated with the 22.22 acres under Truckee River Claim No. 626a as described in the existing place of use.

The issuance of this permit is for the consumptive use portion only, being 2.5 acre-feet per acre of the base right.

The remaining portion of the base right will remain in the river for use by other decreed right holders.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.844 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 55.55 acre-feet annually.


