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The applicant James A. Spear hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 14468, Certificate No. 6372

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- 1. The source of water is an underground source
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.0082 cfs, not to exceed 1.55 acre feet/Annum
3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal purposes
4. The water heretofore permitted for Quasi-Municipal purposes
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 6, Township 22 South, Range 62 East, M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the North Quarter corner of Section 6 bears North 10° 58' 25" East a distance of 1804.60 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 21 South, Range 61 East, M.D.B.&M., Clark County, or at a point which the Northwest Corner of said Section 10 bears North 15° 40' 00" West a distance of 917.00 feet.
7. Proposed place of use is a portion of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 6, Township 22 South, Range 62 East, M.D.B.&M., Clark County, Nevada APN 178-06-202-012 & 027
8. Existing place of use is a portion of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 9 and a portion of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 10, all in Township 21 South, Range 61 East, M.D.B.&M., Clark County, Nevada. APN 162-09-502-001
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works The existing point of diversion is an existing well.
12. Estimated cost of works Fifty-five Thousand Dollars
13. Estimated time required to construct works Two (2) Years
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use Three (3) Years

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 14468, Certificate 6372, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 14468, Certificate 6372, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 68168 and 60411 shall not exceed 5.54 acre-feet annually.

Permit 68168 is granted to provide water service to two (2) lots described by Clark County Assessor's Parcel Numbers 178-06-202-012 and 178-06-202-027.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0082 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 1.55 acre-feet annually.**




