The applicant **Wortman Family 2000 Trust** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion and Place of Use** of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit No. 24582, Certificate No. 7673**

1. The source of water is **an underground source**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.0088 cfs, not to exceed 4.00 ac ft/annum**
3. The water to be used for **Quasi Municipal purposes**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Quasi Municipal purposes**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 22 South, Range 61 East, M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 7 bears South 67° 18' 03" West a distance of 1101.41 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, Township 21 South, Range 61 East, M.D.B.&M., Clark County, or at a point which the NW corner of said Section 10 bears North 15° 40' 00" West a distance of 917.00 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use is a **portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 22 South, Range 61 Est, M.D.B.&M., Clark County, Nevada. APN 177-07-206-002, 014 & 015**
8. Existing place of use is a **portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, and a portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, all in Township 21 South, Range 61 East, M.D.B.&M., Clark County, Nevada. APN 162-09-502-001**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **The existing point of diversion is an existing well.**
12. Estimated cost of works **Fifty-five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00)**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Two (2) Years**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **Three (3) Years**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 24582, Certificate 7673 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 24582, Certificate 7673 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Permit 68207 is granted to provide water service to three lots described by Clark County Assessor's Parcel Numbers 177-07-206-002, 177-07-206-014 and 177-07-206-015.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0088 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

August 2, 2003

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

September 2, 2003

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

August 2, 2004

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 2, 2004


