The applicant **Rockview Dairies, inc.**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 64490**

1. The source of water is **an underground source in Nye County**
2. The amount of water to be changed **1.114 CFS., not to exceed 200 AFA.**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **within the NW.¼ NW.¼ of Section 9, T.17S., R.49E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the NW. corner of said Section 9 bears N. 12° 50' 40" W., a distance of 250 feet**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **the NE.¼ NW.¼ of Section 9, T.17S., R.49E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the NW. corner of said Section 9 bears N 87° 39' 44" W., a distance of 2135 feet**
7. Proposed place of use **210 acres within the W.¼, NW.¼ SE.¼, NE.¼ SE.¼, SE.¼ SE.¼, all in Section 9, T.17S., R.49E., M.D.M.**
8. Existing place of use **210 acres within the W.¼, NW.¼ SE.¼, NE.¼ SE.¼, SE.¼ SE.¼, all in Section 9, T.17S., R.49E., M.D.M.**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **A 14½" dia. X 300' deep driven well with a 100 hp. submersible pump, pipe and wire**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$40,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **6 months**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **1 year**
15. Remarks: **This temporary permit is needed since the well at the original point of diversion is not producing sufficient water. A temporary change permit will allow the driller to search for water at this proposed site.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions.

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 64490, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 64490, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 64489, 64490, 64491 and Temporary Permit 68216-T shall not exceed 1,050 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 210 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **February 28, 2003** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.114 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 200 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed an annual duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:


