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The applicant **Fahnestock Enterprises, Inc.** hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion** of water heretofore appropriated under **all of Permit No. 63203**

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1. The source of water is **underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.73249 cfs, 192.0 afa**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point the **SW¼ of the NE¼ of Section 8, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.M., at a point from which the northwest corner of said Section 8 bears North 64° 35' 19" West a distance of 3312.50 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the **NW¼ of the NE¼ of Section 8, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.M., at a point from which the northwest corner of said Section 8 bears North 65° 25' 00" West a distance of 3191.59 feet. (Well #6)**
7. Proposed place of use **21.87 acs in the SW¼ NE¼ and 40.26 acs in the SE¼ NE¼ of Sec. 8 (subtotal 62.13 acs); also 40.51 acs in the SW¼ NW¼, 40.47 acs in the SE¼ NW¼, 40.44 acs in the SW¼ NE¼, 40.40 acs in the SE¼ NE¼, 35.00 acs in the NW¼ NW¼ and 35.00 acs in the NE¼ NW¼ of Sec. 9 (subtotal 231.82 acs); total of 293.95+/- acs, all in T.22N., R.21E., M.D.M..**
8. Existing place of use **(the Place of Use has not changed.)**
9. Use will be from **March 1 to October 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **March 1 to October 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Existing well, pump and irrigation system.**
12. Estimated cost of works **Completed.**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Completed.**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **3 years**
15. Remarks: **The purpose of this application is to change the point of diversion to a more**

productive well which has been recently drilled. Well #6 is in the process of being plugged and abandoned.

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 63203, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 63203 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 62889, 62890 and 68228 shall not exceed 812.0 acre-feet seasonally.

This permit is issued limited to the irrigation of 48.0 acres within the described place of use.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.7325 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 192.0 acre-feet seasonally and not to exceed a seasonal duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

May 13, 2003

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

June 13, 2003

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

May 13, 2005

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 13, 2005

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

June 13, 2005


