The applicant Robert L. Zerga & Susan A. Zerga, trustees of the Robert L. Zerga Trust and Stewart R. Wilson & Karen C. Wilson hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground
2. The amount of water applied for is 1.0 cfs second-feet
(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for Irrigation
4. If use is for:
(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated 30.000 acres
(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

(2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 19, T.33N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., at a point from which the Northwest Corner of said Section 19 bears N 83° 39' 57" W, 2389.39 feet.
6. Place of Use a portion of the S 1/2 SW 1/4 of Section 18, T.33N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M. and a portion of the N 1/2 NW 1/4 of Section 19, T.33N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M.
7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st of each year.
8. Description of proposed works Drilled well, pipelines and ditches
9. Estimated cost of works \$10,000.00
10. Estimated time required to construct works 3 yrs
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 yrs

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued for the irrigation of 30 acres within the described place of use and is issued as a supplemental right to Humboldt River Proof 00405 and is only to be used when there is no surface water available.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 90 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 3.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

April 5, 2007

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

May 5, 2007

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

April 5, 2009

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

May 5, 2009

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




