The applicant Virgin Valley Water District hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 50172

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **2.0 Second feet**
3. The water to be used for **Municipal and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Municipal and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **the NW¼, SW¼, Section 27, Township 13 South, Range 71 East, M.D.B.&M.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **the SW¼, SW¼, Section 28, Township 13 South Range 71 East, M.D.B.&M. The SW corner of said Section 28, Bears S 45° 02' 00" W at distance of 70.00 feet**
7. Proposed place of use **SEE ATTACHMENT A**
8. Existing place of use **Mesquite Township being a portion of Sections 9, 10, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32 33 and 34 of Township 13 South, Range 71 East, M.D.B. & M. and a portion of Sections 13, 24, and 25 of Township 13 South, Range 70 East, M.D.B.&M., and a portion of Section 5, Township 39 North, Range 16 West, and Section 32, Township 40 North, Range 16 West, S.R.M. Mojave County, Arizona.**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Through a 17.5-inch diameter exploratory well drilled to an approximate depth of 2,500 feet. Should a desirable source of water be encountered well will be completed.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$1,500,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **1 year**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**

Remarks: Should the exploratory well, designated VVWD Well No. 31, encounter sufficient quantity and quality of ground water, the exploratory borehole will be reamed to sufficient diameter to facilitate completion as a municipal supply well within the designated service area of the Virgin Valley Water District. VVWD Well No. 31 is located within Clark County, Nevada. VVWD No. 31 with GPS code phase equipment located at N. 36° 46' 25.396" latitude, W 114° 3' 11.830 longitude

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions.

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 50172, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 50172, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 14347, Certificate 7270; 17833, Certificate 5495; 20361, Certificate 5922; 41120, Certificate 13575; 61594, Certificate 15801; 61595, Certificate 15802, and any certificate issued under Permits 41122, 50172, 50865, 51271, 51272, 51306, 52015, 52017, 52333, 52952, 53026, 53027, 54154, 56244, 56981 and 61975 shall not exceed 2,920 million gallons annually.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **February 28, 2003** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 471.8 million gallons annually.


