

DENIAL OF STATE ENGINEER

The protests to this application are hereby upheld in part and the application is hereby denied on the grounds that there is no unappropriated groundwater at the source of the supply, the proposed use would conflict with existing rights in the Order 1169 basins and the proposed use of the water would threaten to prove detrimental to the public interest in that it would threaten the water resources upon which the endangered Moapa dace are dependent. No ruling is made on the merits of the remaining protest grounds.

The applicant **Dry Lake Water L.L.C.** hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **underground**
2. The amount of water applied for is **10** second-feet
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal Purposes**
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered
 - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks") **Quasi-Municipal Purposes (see #12 remarks)**
 - (d) Power:

 - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, T17S, R63E, M.D.B.&M., or at a point which the SW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, T17S, R63E, bears S84°25'11" W, 578.17 feet, and has a NAD83 Geographic Position of Latitude 36°27'00.235", Longitude 114°56'40.609"**
6. Place of Use **Apex Industrial Park (as shown on "Place of Use" map accompanying applications 66162 through 66166)..Refer to exhibit A.**
7. Use will begin about **January 1st** and end about **December 31st** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **Pump from a drilled well to a storage tank for distribution to users by pipeline**
9. Estimated cost of works **Part of a \$5 million Dollar water distribution system**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **Three years**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **Five Years**

12. Remarks: The combined total duty from this well and from the well permitted under application 66162 will be no more than 7240.2 acre feet consumptive use annually. This application is not intended to appropriate new water but merely to provide reliability for the applicant allowing the combined water usage, in any proportion from the two wells, of 7240.2 acre feet consumptive use annually. The combined diversion rate under the two water rights will not exceed 10 c.f.s.
