APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is also issued subject to the provision that the place of use of the water herein granted is limited to and supplemental to lands having existing water rights.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second or 104.1 acre-feet annually and not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

November 24, 2009

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



The applicant **Zaga Ranches, LLC** hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **underground**
2. The amount of water applied for is **1.000** second-feet
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **irrigation and domestic**
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated **34.7**
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered
 - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")
 - (d) Power:
 - (1) Horsepower developed
 - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Section 36, T.29N., R.56E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 36 bears S 63° 13' 16" W., 1564.54'.**
6. Place of Use **Portions of the NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, and SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 35, NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄, SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄, and SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, Section 36, all in T.29N., R.56E., M.D.M.**
7. Use will begin about **January 1** and end about **December 31** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **well pump, pipeline and ditches**
9. Estimated cost of works **\$15,000.00**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **1 year**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **2 years**

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12. Remarks: This well was authorized by Road and Highway Builders, who have been awarded Federal Highway Contract No. 24-12, to reconstruct the Harrison Pass road from Zaga Lane to Harrison Pass, a distance of 6.2 miles. The contractor had a well constructed on Zaga property within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T.29N., R.56E., M.D.M. In return for permission to use Zaga property for the well site and after the road construction is completed, the contractor will give to the Zagas the physical well and its appurtenances. The Zagas will then use the well for the irrigation of land on their ranch.
