The applicant High Rock Holding, LLC, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Manner and Place of Use of a portion. of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 21637, Certificate 7702

- 1. The source of water is Underground well #15
2. The amount of water to be changed 2.09 CFS, not to exceed 496 acre-feet.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 1, T.35N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of Section 6, T.35N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 63°24'10" E., a distance of 2961.21 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 6, T.35N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 6 bears S. 89°34' W., a distance of 1250.0 feet. (see remarks).
7. Proposed place of use 10 acres, Lot 9; 40 acres, Lot 10; 39 acres, Lot 11; 35 acres, Lot 12; Section 6, T.35N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M. A total of 124 acres.
8. Existing place of use 10 acres, Lot 9; 40 acres, Lot 10; 39 acres Lot 11; 35 acres Lot 12; 35 acres Lot 13; 35 acres Lot 14; 40 acres, NE 1/4 SW 1/4; 39 acres, SE 1/4 SW 1/4; Section 6, T.35N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M. 124 acres being removed from this permit as follows: 10 acres, Lot 9; 40 acres, Lot 10; 39 acres, Lot 11; 35 acres, Lot 12; all in Section 6, T.35N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from March 1 to October 15 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Existing drilled well 200' deep with a 16" casing and equipped with a motor, pump and distribution system.
12. Estimated cost of works Completed under Permit 66600 and 62247
13. Estimated time required to construct works Completed under Permit 66600
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use Two (2) years.
15. Remarks: Refer to map filed under Permit 21637 for existing Point of Diversion. Tie on Certificate 7702 states S. 89°34' E., to SW corner but is actually S. 89°34' W. as shown on the Cultural Map. Refer to map filed under Permit 53334-T for proposed Point of Diversion.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 21637, Certificate 7702 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 21637, Certificate 7702 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.09 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 496 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
