The applicant S. Morgan and Harriet Barber hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 30169 - Certificate No. 10420

- 1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 32.02 acres - 128.08 ac/ft - 0.35 cfs.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic Use
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic Use
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 1, T13N, R25E, MDM, or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 1, bear S 57°59'46" E a distance of 2777.17 feet. Refer to supporting map filed under Permit No. 30259, Certificate 10421.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 27 T14N, R25E, MDM, or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 22, T14N, R25E, MDM, bears N 22°06' 12.9 W, a distance of 5790.13 feet.
7. Proposed place of use Within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 1, E 1/2 NE 1/4, E 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 12 T13N, R25E, MDM, SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 6, W 1/2 NW 1/4 and W 1/2 SW 1/4 of Section 7 T13N, R26E, MDM. Ref to supporting map.
8. Existing place of use See Attachment
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works Well, Pump and an Irrigation Ditch System.
12. Estimated cost of works \$25,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 Years
15. Remarks: Permit No. 30169 - Certificate No. 10420 and Permit No. 60704 - Certificate No. 15531 are supplemental to Walker River Decree Claim Nos. 54 & 55. (13.05 acres, Claim No. 55) of the (32.02 acres, Claim No. 54) being stripped by this application is supplemented by Permit No. 30169 - Certificate No. 10420 and Permit No. 60704 - Certificate No. 15531. The remaining 18.97 acres is supplemented by Permit Nos. 18925, 30169 and 60704.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30169, Certificate 10420 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30169, Certificate 10420 with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 69185, 69186, 69187, 69190, 69192 and any water of the Walker River Decree C-125, and storage water appurtenant to the place of use shall not exceed 278.0 acre-feet per year for the irrigation of 69.5 acres within the described place of use. The permit holder is responsible for insuring delivery of the entitled decreed and storage waters (surface waters) that are supplemental to these ground water permits. In years that the Walker River Irrigation District declares a full allocation of decreed water to the C-125 decree claims supplemental to these permits, or is able to provide full delivery of storage water to lands supplemental to these permits, ground water shall not be pumped from the wells described in these permits. In years that the Walker River Irrigation District declares a reduced allocation of decreed or storage waters to claims supplemental to these permits, then surface waters must be used in entirety before any ground water can be pumped from the wells to complete the allocated duty of acre-feet per acre. In years that the Walker River District has no decreed or storage water, then ground water can be pumped from wells to provide the allocated duty for the permitted place of use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.031 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 34.80 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

July 17, 2004

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

August 17, 2004

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

July 17, 2005

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

August 17, 2005


