The applicant **USDA Forest Service**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Place of Use, Manner of Use of a portion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit #50843 & Certif. #14491**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.0535 second feet (see remarks)**
3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Recreation & Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NE¹/₄ of the SE¹/₄ of Section 10 T19S, R56E or at a point from which East ¹/₄ corner of said Section 10 bears N 7°59'15" East approximately 1222 feet**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **NW¹/₄ of the NE¹/₄ (Tract 43) of Section 15, T19S, R56E, or at a point from which the said N¹/₄ corner of Section 15 bears N 28° W. approximately 6500 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **Clark County Youth Camp and Forest Service Campgrounds located within portions of SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 2 SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 3 SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 3 NE¹/₄ Section 10 SW¹/₄ Section 10 SE¹/₄ Section 10 W¹/₂ W¹/₂ Section 11, Sections 2, 3, 10, and 11, all in T19S, R56E, M.D.B.&M. (highlighted in yellow on map)**
8. Existing place of use **Sections 2, 3, 10, 15 and Tracts 43, 52, 53 and 54 all in T19S, R56E, M.D.B.&M.**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **8" cased well with sanitary seal and submersible pump**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$70,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **30 days**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **2 years**
15. Remarks: **Consumptive use will be for seasonal and year round facilities as described in Item 6. Estimated annual consumptive use will be 8.85 million gallons.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions.

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 50843, Certificate 14491 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 50843, Certificate 14491 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 50843 and 69193-T shall not exceed 50.7 acre-feet annually.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **December 3, 2003** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0535 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 27.16 acre-feet annually.**
