The applicant **Virgin Valley Water district** hereby makes application for permission to change the **point of diversion & place of use** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 53026**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **4.0..cfs.**
3. The water to be used for **Municipal and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Municipal and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NW¹/₄, SW¹/₄, Section 27, T.13S., R71E. M.D.B.&M. from which the West quarter corner of said section 27 bears N. 65° 21' 29" W. a distance of 1098.02 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **government Lot 10, Section 3., T.13S., R71E. M.D.B.&M., from which the SW corner of said section 3 bears S. 30° 55' W., 3,339 ft. dist.**
7. Proposed place of use **.See Attachment A**
8. Existing place of use **...T.13S., R.71E. Sections 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 30 T.13S. R.70E., Sections 12, 13, 24, 25 M.D.B.&M.**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Through 20-inch diameter cased well to a depth of 1600 feet, 700 horsepower line shaft pump and conveyed via 12-inch diameter pipe to existing distribution system.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$1,800,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **1 year., Through 20-inch diameter. cased well to a depth of 1600 feet, 700 horsepower pump line-shaft turbine pump**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**

15. Remarks: Production well to be used for municipal water supply within the service area of the Virgin Valley Water District, which provides services to the communities of Mesquite and Bunkerville, Nevada. VVWD Well 31 will supply water for fire protection and estimated 1500 EDU's

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 53026 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 53026 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 14347, Certificate 7270; Permit 17833, Certificate 5495; Permit 20361, Certificate 5922; Permit 41120, Certificate 13575; Permits 41122, 50172, 50865, 51271, 51272, 51306, 52015, 52333, 52952, 53027, 54154, 56244, 56981, and 61594, Certificate 15801; Permit 61595, Certificate 15802; Permits 61975, 63879, 67729, 67730 and 69273 shall not exceed 3415.41 million gallons annually.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed **4.0** cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 943.6 million gallons annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

March 23, 2007

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 23, 2007

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

March 23, 2011

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

April 23, 2011


