The applicant **TriLyn Partners, LLC** hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **incidental Las Vegas Wash Storm flows in excess of existing rights in the Las Vegas Wash**

2. The amount of water applied for is **water in excess of existing rights (638cfs, Permit #29814) up to 2,029.0 acre-feet annually second-feet**

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet **4000 A.F. (10,000 A. F. storage capacity)**

3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal/Domestic**

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated **n/a**

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered **n/a**

(c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks") **n/a**

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed **n/a**

(2) Point of return of water to stream **n/a**

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **water in excess of 1760.0 c.f.s (bypass conduit capacity) is diverted from Las Vegas Wash into a reservoir by means of an inlet weir, at Lake Las Vegas Resort, S. E. ¼ of S.W. ¼; Section 22, T21S, R63E, MDM at a point from which the SW corner of Section 22 is S 62° 48' 21" W a distance of 1652.13'**

6. Place of Use **Lake Las Vegas Resort, portions of Sections 14, 15, 22 & 23; Township 21 South; Range 63 East, Mt. Diablo Meridian**

7. Use will begin about **January 1** and end about **December 31** of each year.

8. Description of proposed works **Existing twin 84" concrete pipe bypass system and concrete weir together with 190 foot-high earthen dam**

9. Estimated cost of works **\$30,000,000**

10. Estimated time required to construct works **Completed; already in place**

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **Water was put to beneficial use in 1992. Water will be put to beneficial use as it is available.**

12. Remarks: **There is no intent to require upstream dischargers to discharge storm water to meet this permit application. Taking of from 300 to 4,000 acre-feet per year of excess storm water is incidental to the operation of the dam, bypass system, and the Lake Las Vegas. It is anticipated that after the Lake is filled, the Lake level will vary from 1400' to 1404' ASL during the course of one year.**
