The applicant **Sierra Pacific Power Company, Tracy Power Station**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 19884, Certificate 6230**

1. The source of water is **Truckee River**
2. The amount of water to be changed **5.828 cfs, 699.3 acre-feet**
3. The water to be used for **industrial**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **industrial**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, T20N, R22E M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the w $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 33, T20N, R22E, bears S 4 $^{\circ}$ 0'00" E., a distance of 3,150 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T20N, R22E, M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 33, bears S. 40 $^{\circ}$ 39' W., 3395.0 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T20N, R22E., M.D.B.&M.**
8. Existing place of use **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T20N, R22E., M.D.B.&M.**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Pipe under river from gravel pit pond to bank between Tracy Cooling pond. Pump water to surface water make-up system.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$50,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **3 months to 9 months**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **one year.**
15. Remarks: **The Nature Conservancy will be doing work in the Truckee River which will dirty the Truckee River above the Tracy Power Plant. Clean water from the gravel pit pond will replace river water during Nature Conservancy river work. The gravel pit will filter river water needed by the Power Station.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions.

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Permit 19884, Certificate 6230, which changed the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of Claim No. 641, Truckee River Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 19881, Certificate 6572; 19883, Certificate 6229; 19884, Certificate 6230; 28054, Certificate 9207; 28192, Certificate 8768; 29213, Certificate 9199; 29214, Certificate 9200; 29215, Certificate 9201; 29216, Certificate 9202; 60080; 67977; and Temporary Permit 69396-T shall not exceed 4599.9 acre-feet annually.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water diverted from this surface diversion in addition to the amount of water diverted from any wells or other surface diversions used in conjunction with the Tracy Power Plant.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **March 18, 2004** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

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The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 5.828 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 699.3 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:
