The applicant **Desert Inn Improvement Company**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion and Place of Use** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 16939, Certificate 4766**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.32 c.f.s. not to exceed 112 acre-feet annually**
3. The water to be used for **Recreation (Golf Course Irrigation)**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Recreation and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 16 bears N. 16°24'11" E., a distance of 447 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{2}$ corner of said Sec. 16 bears S. 44°59' E., a distance of 1,930 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **Portions NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.**
8. Existing place of use **Portion SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M. (28 acres)**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Water will be diverted from a proposed well and conveyed through the golf course distribution system for irrigation and water feature use on a re-designed and re-constructed golf course.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$550,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **1 Year**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **3 Years**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 16939, Certificate 4766 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 16939, Certificate 4766 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.32 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 112.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

October 23, 2004

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

November 23, 2004

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

October 23, 2006

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

November 23, 2006


