APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 60437 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 60437 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The Permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records must be submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis within 30 days after the end of each calendar year.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 67956, 67957, 69836 and 69837 shall not exceed 120.5 acre feet annually, for the irrigation of 24.1 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0389 cubic feet per second or 10.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

July 15 2012

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



The applicant Rockview Farms, a California Corporation, hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 60437, Certificate 14999

- 1. The source of water is an underground source in Nye County, Nv
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.0389 CFS., not to exceed 10.0 AFA.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NE.1/4 NE.1/4 of Section 9, T.17S., R.49E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the NE. Corner of said Section 9 bears N 87°40'51" E., a distance of 1284 feet
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the NW.1/4 NW.1/4 of Section 15, T.16S., R.48E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the NW. Corner of said Section 15 bears N 86°19'30" W., a distance of 1004 feet
7. Proposed place of use 18.5 acres within the E.1/2 SE.1/4 NE.1/4, Sec. 9, T.17S., R.49E., M.D.M. 5.64 acres within the E.1/2 NE.1/4 NE.1/4 Sec. 9, T.17S., R.49E., M.D.M. 24.14 acres total
8. Existing place of use 2.5 acres within the W.1/2 E.1/2 NE.1/4 NW.1/4 NW.1/4 of Section 15, T.16S., R.48E., M.D.M.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works A 12 in. Dia. X 320 Ft. deep driven well cased all the way, with a 75 hp. submersible pump, pipe and wire
12. Estimated cost of works \$20,000
13. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years, presently completed, item 11
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years
