January 2, 2008







The applicant **James M. Blasco Family LTD. Partnership**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Diversion of a portion of the waters from the Howard Ditch** of water heretofore appropriated under **Claim No. 63 of the Walker River Decree, United States of America vs. Walker River Irrigation District et. al. in Equity C-125, U.S. District Court.**

To arrive at the total cfs for the Howard Ditch, we subtracted 1,360 cfs (priority 1872), 1,080 cfs (priority 1892), and 0.120 cfs (priority 1904) from the total 5.207 cfs. 5.207 - 1.360 - 1.080 - 0.120 = 2.647 cfs (Howard Ditch)**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of Claim No. 63 of the waters of the Walker River as appears in "Docket in Equity" C-125 filed April 15, 1936, in the District Court of the United States of America in and for the District of Nevada, is issued subject to the terms, conditions and irrigation period imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Permit 69841 is issued for 2.647 cubic feet per second from the decreed source for the irrigation of 133.55 acres.

As a condition of this permit, the Applicant must submit with the proof of completion, a map showing the complete system, location of other users on the Hilburn Ditch and details of where the waters under this permit will be conveyed over the East Walker River.
