The applicant **Alvin C. Bells and Marilyn M. Bells, dba Bell Vista, Inc.**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion and Place of Use** of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit No. 61403**

1. The source of water is **underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **.0088 CFS, 3.85 A.F.A., .77 AC's**
3. The water to be used for **irrigation**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **irrigation**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **in the SE¼ of the SE¼ of Section 25, T.19S., R.52E., M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 25 bears S 69°46'03" E a distance of 1051.62' feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **in the NW¼ of the NE¼ of Section 27, T.19S., R.53E., M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 27 bears North 72°29'20" East a distance of 2111.13' feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **a portion of the SE¼ of the SE¼ of Section 25, T.19S., R.52E., M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada being within Lot's 35 and 36 of Bell Vista Subdivision, Unit No. 4, Document No. 69264 dated 7-3-78 recorded in the official records of Nye County, Nevada.**
8. Existing place of use **.77 AC's in the N½ of the NE¼ of Section 28, T.19S., R.53E., M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada**
9. Use will be from **Jan 1st to Dec. 31st** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **Jan 1st to Dec 31st** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Existing 8" well casing, proposed submersible pump, distribution lines and storage tank**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$5000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **2 – years, existing 8" well casing**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**
15. Remarks: **Existing water rights under Permit #61403 are fan water rights. The proposed point of diversion and place of use will be on the valley floor not on the fan.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 61403 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 61403 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

Permit 69953 is granted for irrigation of 0.77 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0088 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 3.85 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

February 18, 2006

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

March 18, 2006

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

February 18, 2009

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 18, 2009

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




