The applicant **James K. Bradshaw and John F. Gardetto**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Place of Use and Manner of Use** of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit #48221, Certificate #14395**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **.0024 cfs, 1.0 afa, .20 acres**
3. The water to be used for **Quasi-Municipal**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, T.21S., R.54E., M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada** at a point from which the **N $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 18 bears N 14°53'18" W a distance of 1402.08' feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within in the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada** at a point from which the **NW corner of said Section 12 bears N 85°29'06" W a distance of 3071.14 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use a portion of the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada** known as **Parcel #1 of Parcel Map, Doc. #424728 dated 7-30-97 Nye County Recorders Office, Nye County, Nevada - APN #45-225-17**
8. Existing place of use a portion of the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.M., Nye County, Nevada** as shown on accompanying map to support this application.
9. Use will be from **Jan. 1st to Dec. 31st** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **Jan. 1st to Dec. 31st** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **existing 8" well casing, pressure tank, submersable pump and distribution system**
12. Estimated cost of works **existing well, \$1000 meter and ass. fixtures**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **2 years**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**
15. Remarks: **This existing water system presently provides water to two (2) separate residential buildings; one (1) 1152 sq. ft. and one (1) 1248 sq. ft. connected by a 600' sq. ft. garage with minimal desert type landscaping.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 48221, Certificate 14395 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 48221, Certificate 14395 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

Permit 69955 is granted to provide water service to an additional residence on Nye County Assessor's Parcel Number 45-225-17.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0024 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 1.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

June 9, 2006

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

July 9, 2006

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

June 9, 2009

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

July 9, 2009

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




