The applicant **MR. G. GEOFFREY EDWARDS** hereby make application for permission to change the **POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE OF A PORTION** of water heretofore appropriated under **Claim No. 193** of the **Truckee River Decree**, said Decree entered by the **District Court of the United States in and for the District of Nevada** in that certain action entitled **"The United States of America, Plaintiff vs. Orr Ditch Water Company, Etal, Defendants,"** in Equity Docket No. A-3. (Irwin-Mayberry Ditch)

1. The source of water is **TRUCKEE RIVER**
2. The amount of water to be changed **4.40 AFA with a proportionate share of diversion rate**
3. The water to be used for **AS DECREED**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **AS DECREED**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **WITHIN THE SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ OF SECTION 18, T19N., R19E, MDM, AT A POINT FROM WHICH THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 18 BEARS S 21°26'42" E, A DISTANCE OF 989.0 FEET. (REFER TO ATTACHED SUPPORTING MAP).**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **THE NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ OF SECTION 19, T19N, R19E, MDM, A POINT FROM WHICH THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 19 BEARS N 84°25' E, A DISTANCE OF 3375.0 FEET, (AS DECREED – ALSO REFER TO SUPPORTING MAP UNDER PERMIT NO. 67182).**
7. Proposed place of use **AS DECREED – WITHIN A PORTION OF THE SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ OF SECTION 18 AND THE SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ OF SECTION 17, T19N, R19E, MDM. TOTALING 1.97 IRR. ACRES, REFER TO DWR MAP – TR-025 FOR PLACES OF USE (PARCELS 39-290-26 & 27)**
8. Existing place of use **1.04 ACRES WITHIN THE SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ OF SECT. 17 & SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ SECT. 18 (39-290-27) & 0.06 ACRES WITHIN THE SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ OF SECT. 18 (39-290-26), ALL IN T19N, R19E, MDM. AREA TOTALING 1.10 IRRIGATED ACRES. (STRIPPING ALL OF APN 39-290-27 AND A PORTION OF APN 39-290-26).**
9. Use will be from **AS DECREED** to **AS DECREED** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **AS DECREED** to **AS DECREED** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **PUMP AND MOTOR.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$10,000.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **APPROX. THREE (3) MONTHS.**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **TWO (2) YEARS.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim 193, Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A totalizing meter must be installed at the point of diversion and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the Federal Water Master within 10 days from the end of each month, which shall include the amount of water diverted and the amount of water used.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is limited to the irrigation of 1.10 acres within the described place of use. The period of use is as decreed.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.049 cubic feet per second, or 4.40 acre-feet as decreed, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 10, 2008

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

April 10, 2010

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

April 10, 2010
