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The applicant **DAVID LITTLE AND SHERRY LYNN LITTLE**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **POINT OF DIVERSION** of water heretofore appropriated under **PERMIT NO. 65208**

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1. The source of water is **AN UNDERGROUND SOURCE**
2. The amount of water to be changed **1.625 CFS – 422.00 ACRE FEET**
3. The water to be used for **IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC USE**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC USE**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **LOT 7 (SW¼ SW¼) SECTION 6 T14N, R25E, MDM, OR AT A POINT FROM WHICH THE N¼ CORNER OF SECTION 1 T14N, R24E, MDM, BEARS N 28°13'25" W, A DISTANCE OF 5645.87 FEET. REFER TO SUPPORTING MAP FILED UNDER PERMIT NO. 38330.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **LOT 4 (SW¼ SW¼) SECTION 31 T15N, R25E, MDM, OR AT A POINT FROM WHICH THE N¼ CORNER OF SECTION 1 T14N, R24E, MDM, BEARS S 85°44'59" W, A DISTANCE OF 2878.54 FEET. REFER TO SUPPORTING MAP FILED UNDER PERMIT NO. 65208.**

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 65208 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 65208 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled, withdrawn, or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 65209, 65210, 65211, 66913, 66914 and 70112 shall not exceed 2480.0 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.625 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 422.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.




