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The applicant **Board of Regents of the University and Community College System of Nevada on behalf of the University of Nevada Reno** hereby makes application for permission to change the **point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Claim # 130 of The Truckee River Decree, said decree entered in the District Court of The United States for Nevada in that certain action entitled, "The United States of America, Plaintiff, vs. Orr Water Ditch Company, et al., Defendants," in Equity Docket No. A-3.**

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1. The source of water is **Truckee River**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.44 CFS not to exceed 100.00 acre feet annually**
3. The water to be used for **Recreation – golf course irrigation**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **as decreed**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NE¼ SW¼ of Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the Southeast corner of said Section 31 bears S. 62°04' E. a distance of 3195.00 feet (Steamboat Canal)**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SW¼ SE¼ of Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the Southeast Corner of said Section 9 bears S.75°16'E., a distance of 1650.00 feet (Highland Ditch)**
7. Proposed place of use **Section 19, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. E. ½ Section 19 – 153.046 acres APNS 142-020-01; 142-123-18 ALSO, SEE MAP TR-018**
8. Existing place of use **Section 2, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M. NW¼ SE¼ - 5.91 ACRES SW¼ NE¼ - 20.76 ACRES TOTAL 26.67 ACRES Portion of APN 007-020-08 SEE MAP TR-100**
9. Use will be from **JANUARY 1 to DECEMBER 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **AS DECREED**
11. Description of proposed works **Water will be diverted from Steamboat Canal into holding reservoir and then into golf course irrigation system.**
12. Estimated cost of works **Existing**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Existing**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **One Year**

15. Remarks: Water will be commingled with other water resources and used to irrigate the Wolf Run Golf Course.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions.

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim 130, Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on **November 6, 2004** at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.437 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 100.00 acre-feet as decreed.


