The applicant **Russell Lane Parker and Tammy Lavon Parker** hereby make application for permission to change the point of diversion of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit #22891 Certificate 8056**

1. The source of water is **an underground source**
2. The amount of water to be changed **1.34 c.f.s., but not to exceed 625.44 acre-feet per annum**
3. The water to be used for **irrigation and domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **irrigation and domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, T. 34 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M., at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec 24 bears S 67 $^{\circ}$ 34'30" W, 5661.22 feet.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, T. 34 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M., at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec 24 bears S 11 $^{\circ}$ 24'00" W, 1792.00 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **312.72 acres in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 24, T. 34 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M.**
8. Existing place of use **312.72 acres in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 24, T. 34 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M.**
9. Use will be from **1/1 to 12/31 of each year.**
10. Use was permitted from **1/1 to 12/31 of each year.**
11. Description of proposed works **drilled well; pump and motor; water piped to pivot center**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$30,000+**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **16" irrigation well, 500' deep**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **5 years**

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15. Remarks: The existing irrigation well, in the SW¼ of Section 24, was old and not able to pump enough water to irrigate our full permitted acreage. An additional well was drilled, under temporary permit #67179-T, for irrigating a second alfalfa field in the SE¼ of Section 24. An application applying for an additional point of diversion, along with a surveyor's map, was submitted in 2002 to the N.D.W.R. by our agent, Robert E. Morley of High Desert Engineering in Elko, NV

In April 2002, permit #67179-T expired, so we obtained another temporary permit, #68525-T, to continue use of the new well. This permit expired on May 12, 2003, at which time we understood that our diversion application, #68486, was on the State Engineer's desk being processed. However, there has been some delay.

So in case it takes a while longer for the State Engineer to approve our final permit, we are submitting this request for another temporary permit. However, if a decision is made beforehand to approve application #68486, please disregard this temporary application. Thank You.
