APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of the Meadow Valley Wash, as heretofore appropriated under Proof V02274 as appears in the Decree in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights in and to the Waters of Camp Valley Creek, Eagle Valley Creek, Panaca Big Spring, Clover Valley Wash, Meadow Valley Wash and their Tributaries in Lincoln and Clark Counties, Nevada, in the District Court of the Seventh Judicial District of the State of Nevada, in and for the County of Lincoln is issued subject to the terms, conditions and irrigation period imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water diverted from this source and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Proof V04345 and Permit 70260 shall not exceed 793.5 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 158.7 acres.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.971 cubic feet per second and not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources, but not to exceed 793.5 acre-feet as decreed.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 12 2012

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


