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The applicant **United States of America, United States Department of Agriculture, Forest Service**, hereby makes application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 60744**

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1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **0.467 cfs, not to exceed 142.67 AFS**
3. The water to be used for **Snowpack Augmentation (snowmaking)**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Snowpack Augmentation (snowmaking)**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **SW/4 Sec. 31, T.13N., R.19E., MDM, or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 31 bears South 43°26' West, 1533 feet**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SE/4 Sec. 31, T.13N., R.19E., MDM, or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 31 bears South 64°52' West, 2173 feet**
7. Proposed place of use within portions of the **W/4 Sec. 29, portions of the E/4, SE/4NW/4 and E/4SW/4, Sec. 30, E/4 and portions of the W/4 Sec. 31, NW/4 Sec. 32, T.13N., R.19E.; portions of the SE/4 Sec. 36, T.13N., R.18E.; portions of the E/4 Sec. 1, T.12N., R.18E.; W/4E/4, and portions of the E/4E/4 and W/4 Sec. 6, T.12N., R.19E., MDB&M. The place of use is in Douglas County, Nevada within the Carson River Hydrographic Basin**
8. Existing place of use **no change**
9. Use will be from **June 15 to April 15** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **June 15 to April 15** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works. **well, pump, motor, reservoir, and pumping and pipeline distribution system for snowmaking equipment**
12. Estimated cost of works **in excess of \$50,000**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **6 months**

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APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions.

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 60744 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 60744 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

A report shall be submitted to the State Engineer at the end of May of each year indicating the amount pumped from each well and the amount used from Daggett Creek for snow making purposes.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 60744, 60746, 60747 and Temporary Permit 70330-T shall not exceed 713.35 acre-feet annually of which 570.68 acre-feet is non-consumptive. The total combined duty of water under Permits 60744, 60745, 60746, 60747, 60748 and Temporary Permit 70330-T shall not exceed 1327.12 acre-feet annually of which 1061.7 acre-feet is non-consumptive.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on April 15, 2004 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.
