## THE STATE OF NEVADA PERMIT TO CHANGE POINT OF DIVERSION, MANNER OF USE AND PLACE OF USE OF THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA HERETOFORE APPROPRIATED

**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 13032, Certificate 4259, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 13032, Certificate 4259 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is also issued subject to the provision that the place of use of the water herein granted is limited to and supplemental to lands having existing water rights under Little Humboldt River Decree Proofs DLH 00652D and DLH 00673.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 70384, 70385 and 70386 shall not exceed 1584.00 acre-feet for the irrigation of 440 acres.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 4.80 cubic feet per second or 1288.80 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a seasonal duty of 3.60 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

**July 22, 2009**

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

**July 22, 2011**

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

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The applicant Cain Family Trust, hereby makes application for permission to change the point of diversion, place of use, and manner of use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 13032 Certificate 4259

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- 1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 4.80 cfs
3. The water to be used for irrigation
4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 13, T.39N., R.39E., MDB&M or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 13 bears S 76°32' E 2532.00 feet
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 14, T.39N., R.39E., MDB&M or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 14 bears S 45°00' E 70 feet
7. Proposed place of use 358 acres within Section 23 and the W 1/2 W 1/2 of Section 24, and the S 1/2 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 14, and the S 1/2 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 13, T.39N., R.39E., MDB&M
8. Existing place of use 72 acres in the NW 1/4, 18 acres within the SW 1/4, 136 acres within the NE 1/4, and 132 acres within the SE 1/4, all in Section 23, T.39N., R.39E., MDB&M (358 acres total)
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from March 15 to September 30 of each year.
